What is a LBTIQA+?

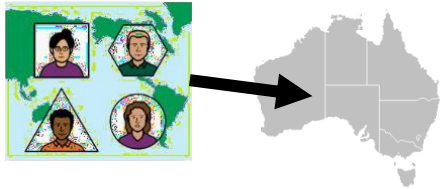


- rural, regional or remote

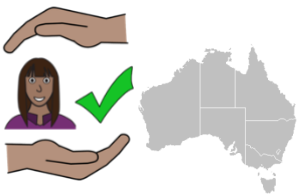

You came to

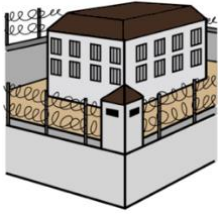
Australia to be safe.

This means you don't have much money for important things. Like

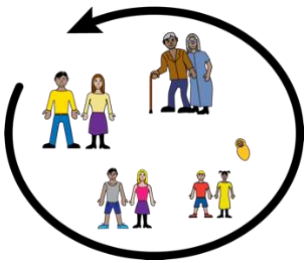

- medications.



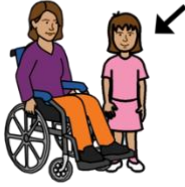
